

How to Install Vinyl

Tools Required:

- Masking tape
- Squeegee
- Glass (surface) cleaner
- Paper Towels
- Measuring tape

Prep the Surface:

Take your glass (surface) cleaner and prep the area by thoroughly cleaning the area where the decal will be placed. Allow the area to fully dry. When installing outside, it's best to apply in warm temperatures.

Measure the dry area to find the center point of where you want to place your decal. Using the masking tape, tape the decal to that area.

From the side of the decal, pull away a small portion of the paper backing and fold down the exposed backing to prevent it from curling back up. Place the exposed adhesive onto the surface and using the squeegee slowly smooth it out.

Slowly start removing the paper backing and smooth the decal out with the squeegee. (This step is helpful with another person depending on how large the decal is). Make sure to slowly remove the protective backing in small portions – a little at a time.

Once the decal is fully applied, squeegee from the center toward the outer edges to remove air bubbles. Remove the masking tape and squeegee the top of the vinyl decal. Most bubbles can be pressed outward with a squeegee. If the bubble won't disappear, use a razor blade or sharp pin to puncture the bubble, then gently use your finger to press down the decal and remove the air. Work slowly to avoid wrinkles.
